#### A Guest's Perspective

"Imagine it is the worst day in early December of the worst year of your life. My son Scott had been fighting cancer for most of the year, and I now Know he is losing his battle. It has become obvious that difficult decisions must be made, and I had just made one that broke my heart. Tomorrow, the caregivers at Kindred Hospital in Sycamore would start the necessary changes - heart-breaking changes - in my son's treatment. It's late; I mention that I need to get home - a 35 minute drive on dark, unfamiliar curving roads - and that I will be back early the next morning. Someone comes and talks to me about "Pay It Forward [House]," an organization that puts individuals in my situation in a nearby hotel and only asks for a \$10 per day donation.

How would you feel? For this mother - in my heart - this was a God send. How beautiful that absolute strangers would have such kindness for me. I felt their loving care at a time of my greatest need. My husband and I stayed for four nights. This allowed me to be at the hospital from early in the morning till the evening hours. It allowed my husband to leave in our car to make the necessary arrangements during the day.

Most importantly it gave me the time to be with my son, to sense what he was going through and to help him adjust slowly to his new reality. I talked of childhood memories and playmates. I sang him songs and told him stories he had first heard in Sunday School. As I gently held his hand, we prayed together. The opportunity Pay It Forward provided for my husband and me to stay at a local hotel allowed us to bond in our shared feelings and peaceful and quiet reflection during the time that otherwise would have been spent driving back and forth to our home.

We both immediately knew that we wanted to support the loving efforts of those individuals doing the day-to-day work of Pay It Forward, to allow them to provide the same feelings of peace and being cared for to the next family with a loved one requiring treatment such as my son Scott received at Kindred. Post Script: After leaving Kindred on Friday, December 16 for CrossRoads in Woodstock, my son Scott passed away at 7:25a.m. on Sunday December 18. He can now rest pain free in peace."
